One of the most basic questions of Evangelization is, "Does God Exist and how can I know it?" There are two kinds of Atheists we might encounter these days. The first kind is the most common and is referred to as the "Practical" Atheist." They do not explicitly deny God's

existence but simply choose to live as though He did not exist. He is irrelevant to them and to their daily life. He might as well not exist. The other kind of atheist, less common, is the one who simply denies that God exists. To both of these kinds of atheists, quoting scripture isn't going to work since it is not an agreed upon point of reference. But try starting here. Ask them about their desire and to ponder that their desire is infinite—without limit. Most will admit this truth that our desires are endless. But then ask how a finite (limited) world can provide an infinite (unlimited) desire. For me to give you \$20 means I have to have it first. But if the world is limited and doesn't have infinity, how can it give me infinite desire? This desire must come from something, or someone, who is infinite. This "someone" we call God. He has written His name on our hearts and our infinite longing is "proof" that He exists!


